ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. ADOBELAND and GAMMA are allies with very strong and consolidated defence cooperation programmes.
2. ADOBELAND is a democratic and highly developed country. However, it has very tense relations with the neighbouring country of PETTRA. In recent years that have been border clashes and armed conflict with insurgents.
3. PETTRA is a large country, economically underdeveloped with excellent natural resources, mainly minerals. Last year, the 'PETTRA Spring' led to the removal of an authoritarian leader with a democratically elected parliament. PETTRA's international behaviour has dramatically improved since and the UN Security Council lifted sanctions this year. However, there are still rebel groups located along the border with ADOBELAND, led by members of the previous regime's family, that seek to undermine the transition by violent means.
4. ADOBELAND strongly supported the change of regime in PETTRA. The rebels in PETTRA therefore also conduct terrorist activities directed towards ADOBELAND.
5. The former leader of PETTRA and his family are living in DELLTA under the protection of its government.
